United States Census 2020

We've all heard the importance of participating in the census and how it shapes the future of our community. Here is some important information coming to you soon.

How the 2020 Census will invite everyone to respond:

Every household will have the option of responding online, by mail, or by phone. Nearly every household will receive an invitation to participate in the 2020 Census from either a postal worker or a census worker.

- ✓ **95% of households will receive their census invitation in the mail**
- ✓ **Almost 5% will receive their census invitation from a census taker in person**
- ✓ **Less than 1% will actually be counted by a census taker**

What to Expect in the Mail

On or between March 12-20, you should receive a census invitation to respond. Every household will have the option of responding online, by mail, or by phone. You will receive a reminder letter on or between March 16-24. If you haven't responded by the first week in April 2020, you may receive additional reminder letters and postcards. In addition, a census taker may follow up in person if you have not responded.

Note: mail from the Census Bureau will always have "U.S. Census Bureau" or "U.S. Department of Commerce" in the return address on the envelope.

How to identify a census taker or Census Bureau field representative:

If you are visited by someone from the Census Bureau, they may be working on the 2020 Census or one of their other surveys. The Census Bureau conducts over 100 surveys throughout the country in addition to the decennial census. Census representatives will be at local organizations and community events with computer tablets to help individuals respond online to the 2020 Census. The best way to avoid being visited at home by a census taker, or enumerator, is to complete the 2020 Census online, by phone, or by mail.

Here are some ways you can verify an individual is a Census Bureau employee:

The census taker or field representative will present an ID badge that includes:

- ✓ **Their name**
- ✓ **Their photograph**
- ✓ **A Department of Commerce watermark**
- ✓ **An expiration date**

They will have an official bag and Census Bureau-issued electronic device, such as a laptop or smartphone, bearing the Census Bureau logo.

Census takers and field representatives will conduct their work between the hours of 9am and 9pm, local time. 🌿

What About The Security of My Data?

The Census Bureau is bound by Title 13 of the U.S. Code to keep your information confidential. Under Title 13, the Census Bureau cannot release any identifiable information about you, your home, or your business, even to law enforcement agencies. The law ensures that your private data is protected and that your answers cannot be used against you by any government agency or court.

The answers you provide are used only to produce statistics. You are kept anonymous: The Census Bureau is not permitted to publicly release your responses in any way that could identify you or anyone else in your home.

The security of Census Bureau systems is a top priority, and our IT infrastructure is designed to defend against and contain cyberthreats. We continually refine our approach to identifying, preventing, detecting, and responding to these threats.

Novel Coronavirus Information

The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health (Public Health) is cooperating with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to respond to a recent spread of the novel (new) coronavirus.

Coronaviruses are a large family of viruses, some causing respiratory illness in people and others that circulate mostly among animals. Common symptoms in an infected person include fever, cough and shortness of breath or difficulty breathing.

Although there is not a direct threat to the Agoura Hills community, the City is taking a precautionary approach and encouraging everyone to help slow or prevent the spread of the virus. The risk for contracting the COVID-19 virus remains low, it is a good time to practice measures of hygiene.

HERE ARE SOME ACTIONS RECOMMENDED BY HEALTH OFFICIALS:

- Stay home when you are sick.
- Washing hands often with soap and water for 20 seconds. Using an alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
- Covering your nose and mouth with your elbow or a tissue when coughing or sneezing.
- Avoiding touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Limit close contact, like kissing and sharing cups or utensils, with people who are sick.

The City of Agoura Hills has contingency plans in place, should they be necessary, to provide vital services to the community following any local breakout. No actions are recommended at this point from health officials but the City will continue to monitor and address any and all concerns that arise. 

