**City Manager Appoints Ramiro S. Adeva III as New Community
Development Director**

(Agoura Hills, CA) – Agoura Hills City Manager Greg Ramirez appointed Ramiro S. Adeva III as the new Community Development Director effective December 16, 2019. Adeva fills the vacant role at the City after spending the past 8 years as the Director of Public Works / City Engineer. Adeva’s familiarity with the City’s goals and vision, along with his well-established roots in the community were critical in the decision-making process.

“I’m humbled and honored to continue serving the community of Agoura Hills in my new role” Adeva said. “Our city is special, and I embrace the challenges that lie ahead, and look forward to delivering projects that the residents and businesses of Agoura Hills can be proud of. We have much to do in the world of Public Works, Planning and Building & Safety moving forward, but I am confident that together we can achieve goals set forth by the City Council and community.”

Adeva is a registered Civil Engineer in California. He holds a Bachelor’s Degree in Civil Engineering from California State Polytechnic University and a Master’s Degree in Public Administration from the Sol Price School of Public Policy at University of Southern California.

Adeva began his career with the City of Agoura Hills in 2002 in the Public Works Department. He then continued his municipal work at the City of Ontario from 2004 to 2007, until he returned to Agoura Hills as the City Engineer. He was promoted to Director of Public Works in 2011, where he served until being tapped to become the new Director of Community Development.

During his tenure as Director of Public Works, the Department was able to deliver high profile projects such as the Agoura Road Widening Project and Reyes Adobe Interchange. He was instrumental in working with Metro to secure over \$40 million dollars of the City’s 30-year allocation of Measure R dollars within the first 5-years of the measure.

Adeva will oversee the Public Works, Planning, and Building & Safety Departments in his new role at the City of Agoura Hills. His first major project will include the facilitation of the review of the Agoura Village Specific Plan which is currently underway. City Management expects to fill the now vacant Public Works Director role in the near future.
